

How do I report an exemption?

Find out how exemptions are reported and what exemption types are available

New Mexico Board of Nursing

An exemption reduces or eliminates the need to complete continuing education credits. To determine if you qualify for an exemption:

- Log into your CE Broker account
- Click Report CE (or Report Hours)
- Click on the Report Exemptions tab
- Click Learn More under the appropriate exemption

The **Learn More** button will give a brief explanation about the exemption. If you're curious about eligibility requirements, refer to your state Board website or contact them directly.

Once you've determined you are eligible, click **Begin** to get started!

Available Exemption Types

→ **Certification or Recertification in the registered nurse specialty area**

◆ *Available to Licensed Practical Nurses and Registered Nurses*

Certification or recertification in the registered nursing specialty area. Certification or recertification granted by a national professional organization which uses criteria designed to recognize competence in a specialized area of nursing practice may be used as approved CE. Verification of certification or recertification within the current renewal period is accepted in lieu of the 30 hours of CE required for licensure.

Documentation Required: Please be prepared to upload a copy certification or recertification.

→ **Not Registered with the DEA**

◆ *Available to Licensed Practical Nurses and Registered Nurses*

Advanced practice nurses that have prescriptive authority but are not actively registered with the DEA should claim this exemption to reset their transcript and eliminate the CE requirement required for a DEA license. Once you submit this request your transcript will be updated immediately.

No documentation is required.
