NCLEX NEW RULES FAQ's

Instructions: Please use scenarios below that best describes your current situation in order to provide guidance as to how to proceed in the initial application process.

Scenario 1a

I graduated nursing school in the US less than 2 years ago and have not taken the NCLEX

Scenario 1b

I graduated nursing school in another country and I practiced or volunteered nursing in another country and I have never taken the NCLEX

Scenario 1c

I graduated nursing school in the US less than 2 years ago and I have not sat for the NCLEX more than 8 times.

Scenario 1d

I graduated nursing school in another country less than 2 years ago and I did not practice nursing in another country and I have not sat for the NCLEX more than 8 times.

Scenario 2a

I graduated nursing school in the US more than 2 years ago and have not taken the NCLEX

Scenario 2b

I graduated nursing school in another country more than 2 years ago and I did not practice nursing in another country.

Scenario 2c

I graduated nursing school in another country more than 2 years ago and attempted the NCLEX more than 8 times.

Scenario 2d

I graduated nursing school in the US more than 2 years ago and attempted the NCLEX more than 8 times.
